LOCAL ARTISTIC WORKSHOP

DURATION: 12 MONTHS (MAY 2026 – APRIL 2027)

AIMS

- To involve groups of young people (18-30 years old, also including “fragile” people) to reflect and debate about the EU, its concept and aims, its potentials and opportunities offered to them in terms of job placement/experience, training, study, living abroad and travelling;
- To help and allow young people to artistically express their vision of Europe, their expectations deriving from being (or becoming) a European citizen in terms of personal growth, social relations, career, etc.
- To guide young people in creating **artistic products** that could represent their feelings, thoughts, points of view, expectations, opinions, etc. about the EU, its policies, institutions, history, plans and initiatives, which will be shared during the on-line meetings with the other groups of young people from the other partner countries and displayed/shown/presented during the international events.

IMPLEMENTATION

One workshop per month will be organized in each partner country, that will involve around **10 young people** each.

Workshops will begin with a recap of the content covered in the online training (including EU history, policies, institutions, programs, etc.). This will be followed by open debates, giving participants the opportunity to share their views expectations, concerns, and plans regarding the EU.

Under the guidance of artist facilitators, participants will then be encouraged to express their thoughts, feelings, emotions, and ideas through various artistic forms (painting, drawing, dancing, craftsmanship, playing a musical instrument, etc.).

The artistic creations will be completed by the participants at home, and the resulting works will be shared during periodic online meetings.

By the end of the workshop implementation period, at least 12 artistic products will be created and showcased during international events.
